The "79-mile Long Beach to Catalina Island Challenge" was the first recorded USA offshore race in 1911. In 1968, legendary racer and founder of Powerboat Magazine, Bob Nordskog, dubbed this race **The Rum Run**, to commemorate an era when fast boats transported liquor into San Pedro, Oceanside, Long Beach, Santa Barbara and other Southern California ports from offshore islands. Over the years, Bob Nordskog won this race 9 times on courses which varied along Southern California's coastline from Malibu to Huntington Beach.

The Pacific Airshow® was brought to life in 2016, and has been the cornerstone event in Southern California ever since. Pacific Airshow is not just an airshow. Since its launch, the spectacle-scale event has grown to become the largest airshow in the United States by attendance attracting millions of spectators to Southern California every fall.

The three-day weekend features heart-pumping aerobatic demonstrations by the world's finest display teams, an exhilarating boat race around Catalina Island, live music on the beach, VIP meet and greet events, social parties, and so much more.

Start/Finish / Turn 1a (Airshow Buoy 7)

Boats will launch from Sunset Aquatic Marina and proceed south mustering at the Staging Area and merging into an anticlockwise milling circle.

Race Control will clear a boat for their start at intervals (race instructions and pilots briefing).

Once cleared, following rules of the road, each boat must cross the starting line/Huntington Beach Pier (Green Line) within 1 minute. Timing for that specific boat will start as it crosses the starting line/Huntington Beach Pier.





After crossing the start line, proceed .6 miles **Airshow Buoy #7** must be kept to the port Turn southeast toward Ship Rock - Mark 2a.

REQUIRED Mark 2a

The Marine Farm is south of the crossing and is a restricted area. All dive areas are restricted.

Mark 2a – Ship Rock - **Keep to Starboard** and proceed north around Catalina 15 miles to Mark 3.

NOTE: **Ship Rock is a restricted area**. Entry into the dive area will result in penalties (see Race Instructions). This area is high in pleasure boats. It is considered to be one the best dives on Catalina.




