**Formula Drift Pro Championship** racers, **Matt Field** and **Brian Creech**, have been racing together (on pavement) for over 10 years. "We have fulfilled a childhood dream by putting Brian's family boat back together, so the next goal of ours is to enter a race," said Field, adding "We're very thankful to our partners for helping to make this dream of offshore racing possible. Once we decided this race was a go, we sprung into action, equipping the boat with fresh **K&N** oil filters and air filters, a full fill of **Lucas Oil Marine** racing oil, a complete **Rugged Radios** intercom set, and of course, a special set of **Heat Wave Visual** glasses to keep our peepers dialed and protected!"
